2	<b>White Headed Duck</b>	Resident	La Mancha Wetlands, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	La Mancha is the main stronghold of this bird species in Spain.
3	<b>Little Bustard</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava	All year round. Big flocks, up to 400, in Winter	La Mancha has the biggest density of Little Bustards of Spain
4	<b>Pin-Tailed Sandgrouse</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava	All year round	The Bird from La Mancha
5	<b>Great Bustard</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava	All year round	In the Calatrava Steppes breeds the best populations of this amazing bird in all the south of Spain
6	<b>Moustached Warbler</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel	Spring, from March to May	Only found in Tablas de Daimiel., where this tiny bird breeds
7	<b>Iberian Woodpecker</b>	Resident.  Endemic.	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel, Sierra de Andujar	All year round	Very common in the Ciudad Real province. Easily found in the fields around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava).
8	<b>Black Shouldered Kite</b>	Resident	Cabaneros, Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round but easily found in Autumm/Winter	Only breeding in the western side of Ciudad Real province.
9	<b>Bonelli's Eagle</b>	Resident	Valle de Alcudia, Despeñaperros	All year round	Over 27 pairs breeds only in the Ciudad Real province. Easily found in the Sierra Morena area, is really scarce in the rest of the area
10	<b>Azur-Winged Magpie</b>	Resident.  Endemic.	Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros, Sierra de Andujar	All year round	Very common in the fields around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava)



11	<b>Red Footed Falcon</b>	Spring and Autumn	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel, Cabañeros.	Watched on migration	Regular sightings in April/May and October
12	<b>White-Rumped Swift</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Valle de Alcudia, Despenaperros, Cabañeros, Sierra de Andujar, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from May to July	Uncommon spring visitor, it's expanding its territory to the north side of La Mancha
13	<b>Squacco Heron</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	April to July	Common in Tablas de Daimiel & Campo de Calatrava, La Mancha has the best populations of this bird inland Spain.
14	<b>Eagle Owl</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Cabaneros, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Very common in the Ciudad Real province. Perhaps the biggest densities of this powerful night raptor in all Spain.
15	<b>Red-Necked Nightjar</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	Mid May to October	Common in the Ciudad Real province. Easily found in the fields around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava).
16	<b>Black Wheatear</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia	All year round	Very poor known, this specie can be found in most of the hills around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava).
17	<b>Great Spotted Cuckoo</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Sierra de Andujar, Cabañeros, Tablas de Daimiel	Spring time, from March to June	The first migratory bird to enter in La Mancha from Africa. Sometimes seen in January
18	<b>Hawfinch</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia	All year round	Very local and rare, but easy to find in Campo de Calatrava
19	<b>Ferruginous Duck</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Scarce but localised in Tablas de Daimiel and Navaseca Lagoon
20	<b>Gull Billed Tern</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	La Mancha Wetlands, Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	April to July	With scattered breeding locations in the Mediterranean coast, this bird has one of the biggest breeding colonies of Spain in La Mancha Wetlands.



21	<b>Collared Pratincole</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava, La Mancha Wetlands	Spring time, from April to July	Common in all the wetlands of La Mancha
22	<b>Short-Toed Eagle</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Cabañeros, Valle de Alcudia, Campo de Calatrava	April to October	Very common in the area, countless pairs of birds
23	<b>Black Stork</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Valle de Alcudia, Campo de Calatrava, Sierra de Andujar, Despeñaperros, Cabañeros	March to September	Distribution very poor known in all the area, but easily found in all Sierra Morena.
24	<b>Blue Rock Thrush</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia	All year round	Very common in the hills around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava)
25	<b>Black-Bellied Sandgrouse</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava	All year round, but more easy in Winter	Not as common as Pin-Tailed Sandgrouse, this bird is one of the jewels of the Calatrava Steppes
26	<b>Spanish Sparrow</b>	Resident	Cabañeros, Campo de Calatrava.	All year round	Very common and easy to observe in rivers & wetlands
27	<b>Greater Flamingo</b>	Resident	La Mancha Wetlands, Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Greater Flamingo can be seen all year round in La Mancha, whether resident or migratory birds from others parts of Spain.
28	<b>Purple Heron</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava, La Mancha Wetlands	Spring time, from April to July	Very common in the Calatrava wetlands, recently has colonized its ancient stronghold of Tablas de Daimiel
29	<b>Little Bittern</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from April to July	Easy to observe in Tablas de Daimiel, this emblematic bird is one of the main attractions of the park
30	<b>Scops Owl</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros	Spring time, from April to June	Difficult to observe but easy to hear in the La Mancha nights



31	<b>Bearded Tit</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel, La Mancha Wetlands	All year round	Easy to observe feeding in Tablas de Daimiel
32	<b>Cirl Bunting</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia, Sierra de Andujar	All year round	Easy to observe in the Calatrava mountains, easy to hear in most of Sierra Morena
33	<b>Golden Oriole</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia, Sierra de Andujar, Despeñaperros, Cabañeros	Spring time, from April to July	Very shy, this beautiful bird is easy to observe in the Campo de Calatrava
34	<b>Roller</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Cabañeros, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from mid April to July	Very local and rare, but easy to find in both National Parks
35	<b>Iberian Chif Chaf</b>	Resident	Despeñaperros	Spring time, from May to June	Only breeding in this spectacular park of the stunning Sierra Morena
36	<b>Lesser Kestrel</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros	Spring & Summer time	It's the most common raptor in the Campo de Calatrava
37	<b>Montagu's Harrier</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros	Spring time, from April to October	Endangered, every year it's more difficult to observe the gracile flight of this fantastic raptor
38	<b>Stone Curlew</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round but easily found in Spring & Summer	Very common in the fields around Almagro (Campo de Calatrava)
39	<b>Wood Lark</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Cabaneros, Valle de Alcudia, Sierra de Andujar, Despeñaperros	All year round	Easy to find in the steppes inside Cabañeros
40	<b>Calandra Lark</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros, Valle de Alcudia	All year round	Easy to find in the steppes of Campo de Calatrava



41	<b>Garganey</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	La Mancha Wetlands, Tablas de Daimiel	Spring & Autumn time, from March to September	Uncommon spring visitor and breeding bird, with good chances in the the migratory movements in early Spring and early Autumn
42	<b>Glossy Ibis</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from April to October	Very common in the season
43	<b>Bee-Eater</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	All the area	Spring time, from April to August	Very common everywhere
44	<b>Spectacled Warbler</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from April to July	Very rare and local, can be found in quite a few locations in Campo de Calatrava
45	<b>Reed Bunting</b> <i>(whitherby subspecies)</i>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel	Spring and Winter	Very local, the Iberian race <i>whitherby</i> of this bird has only about 400 pairs, mostly in La Mancha and Mallorca
46	<b>Subalpine Warbler</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Cabañeros, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from April to July	Very local but common in the mountains of the area covered with Mediterranean vegetation
47	<b>Spoonbill</b>	Spring & Summer visitor, but also in Winter	Campo de Calatrava, Tablas de Daimiel	Spring time, from March to July	Very common in the wetlands of Calatrava & Daimiel
48	<b>Western Olivaceous Warbler</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel	Spring time, from April to July	Breeding species inside the Park.
49	<b>Purple Swamphen</b>	Resident	La Mancha Wetlands, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Rare but localized, only found in small numbers
50	<b>Dartford Warbler</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Cabañeros, Sierra de Andujar, Valle de Alcudia, Despeñaperros, Campo de Calatrava	Spring time, from April to July	Easy to find in slopes with Rock Rose vegetation



51	<b>Black Vulture</b>	Resident	Cabañeros, Valle de Alcudia, Sierra de Andújar	All year round	Cabañeros has the biggest densities of Black Vulture of the World: 220 plus breeding pairs in just 8.000 Ha.
52	<b>Black-Neck Grebe</b>	Resident	La Mancha Wetlands, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Common in all kind of wetlands
53	<b>Golden Eagle</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Valle de Alcudia, Sierra de Andújar, Cabañeros, Campo de Montiel	All year round	Easy to observe in Campo de Calatrava. Over 100 breeding pairs in the Ciudad Real province.
54	<b>Water Rail</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava	All year round	A common sighting when visiting Tablas de Daimiel
55	<b>Savi's Warbler</b>	Spring & Summer visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, La Mancha Wetlands	Spring time, from April to June	Easy to hear and to see in Tablas de Daimiel
56	<b>Long-Eared Owl</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel, Campo de Calatrava	Winter & Spring time	A common dweller of the Tamarisk trees around the Guadiana river
57	<b>Iberian Shrike</b>	Resident	Campo de Calatrava, Cabañeros, Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Endemic subspecies, considered by some authors as a species itself. In winter the population is increased by countless Grey Shrikes from Central Europe
58	<b>Bluethroat</b>	Winter visitor	Tablas de Daimiel, La Mancha Wetlands	From late September till February	Very common in Tablas de Daimiel shores. Sometimes watched at the end of the summer in their passage
59	<b>Red-Knobed Coot</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	Very rare. Only found in Tablas de Daimiel
60	<b>Marbled Teal</b>	Resident	Tablas de Daimiel	All year round	This endangered bird, only easily found in the Mediterranean coast, has bred in 2011 in La Mancha, with up to 22 adults. Very scarce.
